6. Conifercone Cap (*Baeospora myosura*)
7. Copper Spike (*Chroogomphus rutilus*)
8. Fairy Inkcap (*Coprinellus disseminatus*)
9. False Chanterelle (*Hygrophoropsis aurantiaca*)
10. Field Mushroom (*Agaricus campestris*)
11. Glistening inkcap (*Coprinellus micaceus*)
12. Hare's-foot Inkcap (*Coprinopsis lagopus*)
13. Honey Fungus (*Armillaria mellea*)

16. Shaggy Parasol (*Chlorophyllum rhacodes*)

1. *Bartheletia paradoxa* (leaf fungus on Ginkgo)
2. Canadian Goldenrod mildew (*Golvinomyces cichoriacearum*)
3. Oak mildew (*Microsphaera alphitoides*)
4. Witches Broom (*Taphrina betulina*)
5. Candlesnuff Fungus (*Xylaria polymorpha*)

RUSTS
