Plums and Custard	<i>Tricholomopsis rutilans</i>	NOT YET ON FUNGI LIST
Bulbous Honey Fungus	<i>Armillaria gallica</i>	NEW. Bulbous stems, ring soon disappearing.
Nitrous Bonnet	<i>Mycena leptcephala</i>	NEW. Bleachy/ nitrous smell
The Deceiver	<i>Laccaria laccata</i>	Numerous in several places
Peppery Roundhead	<i>Stropharia pseudocyanea</i>	NEW. Distinctive peppery smell.
Common Earthball	<i>Scleroderma citrinum</i>	
Drab Bonnet	<i>Mycena aetites</i>	NEW. Slight earthy smell
Milking Bonnet	<i>Mycena galopus</i> <i>var. galopus</i>	NEW
False Chanterelle	<i>Hygrophoropsis aurantiaca</i>	NEW
Larch Bolete	<i>Suillus grevillei</i>	
Fragrant Funnel	<i>Clitocybe fragrans</i>	NEW

Spotted Toughshank	<i>Collybia maculata</i>	NEW
Cup Fungus (2-3mm across with stem (4-5mm))	<i>Helotiaceae family?</i>	Growing on /adjacent to base of Soapy Knight.
Soapy Knight	<i>Tricholoma saponaceum</i>	NEW. Knight.
Russet Toughshank	<i>Collybia dryophila</i>	NEW
Snowy Waxcap	<i>Hygrocybe virginea var virginea</i>	
Variable Oysterling	<i>Crepidotus variabilis</i>	NEW. On dead bramble stem.
Holly Speckle	<i>Trochila ilicina</i>	
SilkyPinkgill	<i>Entoloma sericeum</i>	NEW. Strong mealy smell
Split Porecrust	<i>Schizopora paradoxa</i>	NEW
Lilac Bonnet	<i>Mycena pura</i>	NEW
Crystal Brain	<i>Exidia nucleata</i>	NEW. On dead branches.
Shaggy Parasol	<i>Chlorophyllum rhacodes</i>	Under a Holm Oak
Clustered Toughshank	<i>Collybia confluens</i>	NEW
Trooping Funnel	<i>Clitocybe geotropa</i>	NEW
Shaggy Scalycap	<i>Pholiota squarrosa</i>	
Giant Puffball	<i>Calvatia gigantea</i>	Badly damaged specimen
Clouded Funnel	<i>Clitocybe nebularis</i>	NEW
Shield Pinkgill	<i>Entoloma clypeatum</i>	NEW. Mealy smell, on soil, NOT wood. Unusual fruiting time.
Wood Woollyfoot	<i>Collybia peronata</i>	NEW

	<i>Inocybe sindonia</i>	NEW. Fibrecap. On grass.
Leaf Parachute	<i>Marasmius epiphyllus</i>	
Yellow Fieldcap	<i>Bolitius titubans</i>	NEW
Jelly Ear	<i>Auricularia auricula-judae</i>	On Weeping Beech (dead branches).
Glistening Inkcap	<i>Coprinellus micaceus</i>	
Flowery Blewit	<i>Lepista irina</i>	NEW. (Initially identified as Clustered Domecap)
-	<i>Agaricus impudicus</i>	NEW
Inky Mushroom	<i>Agaricus moelleri</i>	
-	<i>Agaricus fuscofibrillosus</i>	NEW. Cut flesh turns rosy pink, esp. at top of stem.
Fly Agaric	<i>Amanita muscaria</i>	
Ugly Milkcap	<i>Lactarius turpis</i>	NEW. Single, old specimen.
Yellow Stainer	<i>Agaricus xanthodermus</i>	
Oak Pin	<i>Cudoniella acicularis</i>	NEW. On Horse Chestnut stump.
Smoky Bracket	<i>Bjerkandera adusta</i>	NEW. On Horse Chestnut stump.
Oak Bracket	<i>Inonotus dryadeus</i>	NEW. On Horse Chestnut stump.
Red Cracking Bolete	<i>Xerocomellus chrysenteron</i>	NEW
Common Rustgill	<i>Gymnopilus penetrans</i>	NEW
Mealy Funnel	<i>Clitocybe vibecina</i>	NEW
Common Funnel	<i>Clitocybe gibba</i>	NEW
Death Cap	<i>Amanita phalloides</i>	Pale form
Sepia Bolete	<i>Xerocomus porosporus</i>	NEW
Beech Milkcap	<i>Lactarius blennius</i>	NEW
Dead Man's Fingers	<i>Xylaria polymorpha</i>	NEW. On Horse Chestnut stump.
Slime Mould	<i>Arcyria denudata</i>	NEW. On Horse Chestnut stump.
Small Stagshorn	<i>Calocera cornea</i>	NEW. On Horse Chestnut stump.
Brittlegill	<i>Russula sp</i>	Tan –yellow cap. Fruity smell. Not enough left of it to ID
Artist's Bracket	<i>Ganoderma applanatum</i>	NEW. Needs confirmation.
Stinking Dapperling	<i>Lepiota cristata</i>	NEW
Scaly Earthball	<i>Scleroderma verrucosum</i>	NEW
Moss Bell	<i>Galerina hypnorum</i>	NEW
Bay Cup	<i>Peziza badia</i>	NEW
Grey Coral	<i>Clavulina cinerea</i>	NEW
Matt Bolete	<i>Xerocomus pruinatus</i>	NEW
White Fibrecap	<i>Inocybe geophylla</i> var. <i>lilacina</i>	NEW
Split Fibrecap	<i>Inocybe rimosa</i>	NEW
Common Cavalier	<i>Melanoleuca polioleuca</i>	NEW
Ivory Bonnet	<i>Mycena flavoalba</i>	Pale yellow cap
Wood Blewit	<i>Lepista nuda</i>	
Blushing Wood Mushroom	<i>Agaricus silvaticus</i>	Old specimen. Brownish flesh.
Tar Spot	<i>Rhytisma acerinum</i>	Common – on Sycamore leaves.
